

Taking an active role in politics?



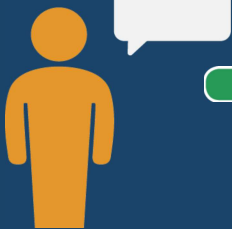

DO



Be respectful and know when to end all political-related discussions

DON'T

Allow a person's political view to impact how you work with them



Speak on behalf of the company unless you are authorized to do so



Use company resources to engage in political activities
